Apply for Peer Observation	From now until April 3rd (Wednesday)	 Eligibility for Application: Teachers who have participated in EMI teacher face-to-face or online training workshops, accumulating more than 4 hours in the advanced courses. Teachers who have participated in the OPEN EMI (GOC) course and obtained a certificate of completion. Teachers can select peer observation partners from the list of participants in the above courses. Once matched, please complete the observation application form separately. Teachers who require feedback on their teaching but do not meet the above qualifications can apply for the pilot teacher service from the university (https://ctdr.nsysu.edu.tw/teacher9.php) (Ms. Wang Yiqing, TLDRC, ext. 2162) or the Resource Center's consultant teacher service (https://emitdc.nsysu.edu.tw/Demo_Class.aspx) (Ms. Su Tian, TLDRC, ext. 2171). Teachers participating in this program must be teaching EMI courses in this semester (112-2) or the next semester (113-1) and must complete both the peer observation and being observed. Records of participation in the peer observation program can be counted as part of the promotion points, but a teacher can only receive credit for the program once. Peer Observation	After completing the pairing ~ May 31st (Friday)	 Three days before the peer observation, the observed teacher (instructor) should submit the lesson plan to the observer and also sent to the organizer. Within 7 days after the class has been completed, the observer should email the filled observation form (including feedback) to the organizer. The Center for Teaching and Learning Development/Resource Center will invite experts to refine the content to enhance its completeness. Therefore, please do not send the observation form to the observed teacher (instructor) at this stage. EMI consultant resources are available this semester to provide feedback on language or teaching aspects during the observation. Teachers are welcome to apply through the registration form. If the peer observation is conducted in the 113-1 semester, it must be completed before the 15th week of that semester (the week before the final exams). Due to different proportions of English-medium instruction (70% for regional universities, 80% for National Sun Yat-sen University), if the observed teacher is from National Sun Yat-sen University, the observer should use the National Sun Yat-sen University observation form. If the observed teacher is from another university, the 	

			observer should use the regional observation form.
